
RT300 Series II Quick Setup Instructions¹

- 1. Use your *User Name* and *Password* to create a new patient record at RTILink.com.
- 2. Setup patient:
 - a. Adjust the pedals according to the patient's size to achieve the desired range of motion when pedaling.
 - b. Secure the patient's wheelchair using the straps that are located at the base of the machine.
- 3. Click "Clinician" and login.
 - 4. Click "Patient" to open the appropriate patient.
 - 5. Click "Therapy" to select your chosen therapy.


6. "Configure" allows you to specify which electrodes are in use and adjust the stimulation parameters for each electrode.



- 7. Adjust the parameters of each individual channel to achieve the desired response.
- 8. To begin, click "GO." This will begin a passive warm-up period (no stimulation). Following the passive warm-up is an active transition phase, which is then followed by active therapy. Following active therapy is a passive cool down to conclude the treatment.



9. If at any time during the treatment session the stimulation needs to be stopped, click "STOP."



Important to Know:

- Check the patient's skin before, during, and after treatment to ensure no adverse responses to the intervention.
- Objective data (e.g., distance propelled and average asymmetry) can be recorded and saved to track patient performance and progress.

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
